CSEB - A NATIONAL SOCIETY

The Canadian Society of Environmental Biologists is a non-profit registered society for biologists in environmental disciplines. CSEB's goal is to apply sound scientific and ecological principles in the management of Canada's natural resources and environment.

The Society was formed in the late 1950's as a professional outlet for Canadian fish and wildlife biologists. Today CSEB has members in a wide range of environmentally-related biological disciplines such as environmental science, botany, and conservation biology as well as the original fields of wildlife, fisheries, soils, zoology and limnology. Members' training and professional outlook present an informed view on problems in the management of Canada's natural environment.

The Society has chapters in eight geographic regions: Atlantic, Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, British Columbia and the Territories.

CSEB MEMBERSHIP

There are three classifications of membership:

Regular members: persons who have graduated from a college or university in a discipline of biological sciences, and who are or have been professionally engaged in teaching, management, or research related to natural resources and environment.

Student Members: persons who are enrolled in an accredited college or university in a discipline of the biological sciences, and who are preparing themselves for professional work in teaching, management, or research related to natural resources and to the application of sound ecological principles to management of the environment.

Associate Members: persons who support the purposes and activities of the Society but who do not qualify for regular or Student membership.

MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

Through its newsletters, meetings, symposia and other activities, the CSEB keeps members informed on current environmental issues.

Members of CSEB also have the opportunity to voice their professional opinions, make public statements, and take action on issues of environmental concern.

The CSEB offers opportunities for contact with biologists outside their own specialties and provides a chance for an integrated approach to common environmental problems.

Membership entitles you to receive the CSEB quarterly publication, *The CSEB Bulletin*, receive information on your local active chapter, get a reduction in registration costs at symposia, and receive substantial price reductions in subscriptions to selected scientific journals.

The Society encourages the active involvement of each member as time and resources permit. Only through the combined efforts and voluntary contributions of its members can the CSEB successfully achieve its goals.
